George Evans Hazel, formerly of South Portland, ME, passed away unexpectedly and peacefully at his home in Bonita Springs, FL on the evening of Sunday, May 26th. George and his wife, Mildred, have been full time residents of Citrus Park in Bonita Springs since 2000 and celebrated their 61st year of marriage in August of last year. George was a graduate of South Portland High School class of 1955. After graduation he enrolled in the United States Army and served in both active and reserve duty with the 5th Armored Division until his discharge as a Sargent First Class in 1967. After discharge he worked in the HVAC field and taught as adjunct faculty at Southern Maine Community College until retirement in 2010.
