Robert Louis Meade of Fort Myers, Florida passed away peacefully on Friday, April 19, 2019 following some recent health challenges. He was 89 years old. Robert was born in Waltham, Massachusetts on February 12, 1930, the proud son of Mary (Gately) and George Meade. He was a Korean War Veteran of the United States Marine Corps who participated in combat operations and received a Purple Heart for injuries received during the course of battle. He later attended law school and became a prominent attorney-at-law in Massachusetts until his retirement from active practice and subsequent relocation to Florida. Bob was known to be a serious man of few, but carefully selected, words. He expected much from the people around him and always inspired them by expecting and delivering the same high standard of himself. Bob leaves behind his longtime companion Lois Boudreau of Fort Myers, Florida who will dearly miss his companionship. Bob will also be warmly remembered and greatly missed by all he knew.
