Her crowded bedside reflected the rest of her life, where Margaret's kindness, warmth and sly humor meant she was always surrounded by family and friends and held in deep affection by all who knew her. Margaret was born in Lock Haven, Pennsylvania, on September 24, 1923, the fifth of John W. and Bridgette Hurley Young's six children. She is predeceased by her brothers William and Joseph Young and her two sisters, Catherine Welliver and Marie Clohesy. She is survived by her youngest brother, George Young. She met Walter Zuroski, her husband of sixty-five years, while he was studying at the Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania and they married in 1948.
