Wayne Timothy Smith, 75, a Ft. Myers, FL, resident since 2000, formerly of West Poland, ME passed away on Monday, November 5th, 2018 in Ft. Myers Florida. He suffered a sudden onset of pulmonary fibrosis that took him from the world quite unexpectedly. He was born in Worcester, MA on June 14th, 1943 to Olive and Ernest Smith, now deceased. Wayne was a United States Navy Veteran. Upon getting his degree from Worcester State College, he entered the Naval Air Corps. He graduated from the Pensacola air flight training school and became a flight instructor. During the Vietnam conflict, he flew C-130's from Japan to the war zone.
