Betty Jo Hood of Fort Myers, Florida passed away peacefully with her loving family by her side on Tuesday, July 10, 2018 following some recent health challenges. She was 86 years old. Betty was born in Tallahassee, Florida on August 25, 1931 to Edward and Alberta Becton. She grew up in Madison, Florida and then moved to Pensacola, Florida where she performed secretarial work. She then met her eventual husband of 64 years – Wayne K. Hood, Jr. – a consequent Navy Senior Chief Petty Officer of the Korean and Vietnam Wars with over 20 years of service. Their sons are Wayne K.
