Patricia A. Anderson of Cape Coral, Florida passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 30, 2018 at Royal Palm Retirement Center in Port Charlotte. She was 81 years old. Patricia was born in Lake Placid, New York on April 20, 1936, and had a very full life including serving in the United States Army from 1955-1958, telephone operator, dairy farmer, school bus driver, and finished up her career as a switchboard operator and 911 call taker for the Lee County Sheriff's Office.
