Carolyn and her four sisters, Myra, Linda, Eva and Joyce were raised believing in God and serving Him. Upon graduation, Carolyn moved to Memphis and was a secretary at First Assembly of God in Memphis. Carolyn later moved to Indianapolis, In and met David Lee Paschall. They were married on April 3, 1964. God shared Carolyn with David for 53 years, 3 months and 1 day. Carolyn worked at Inland Container, McCormick Foods, and retired in 2000 from American Trans Air. In April of 2000 they moved to Cape Coral, Fl. Carolyn worked for Steve Krieg Realty and Dreamtime Entertainment. Carolyn sincerely believed that God was her Savior and served him in various volunteer positions at Fort Myers First Assembly of God.
