Mary Jane's career in design began in the Chicago theater district where she worked as a make-up artist. Her journey and love for Design Fashion continued to include starting her own cosmetic line at her mother's Beauty Salon (Sauganash, IL). During this time, Mary Jane was doing fashion Modeling and Dress Design work for top clothing companies. Her vast experience in design lead on to her becoming the youngest design buyer from New York to Chicago. She became one of the first female entrepreneurs to open a Designing Retail store in Chicago (Michigan Ave.) creating and selling hand painted neckties. This was one of her fondest benchmarks.
