**R**obert F. Steimel of Fort Myers, Florida passed away suddenly on Monday, August 15, 2016. He was born on December 19, 1932 in New York, New York and was the proud son of Frances (Smith) and John Steimel. He was 83 years old at the time of his death. Robert was a Veteran of the U.S. Army who served during the Korean War. He spent the majority of his working life in the publishing business and rose through the ranks to become Vice President of Production for a company specializing in trade newspapers. He was married to and is survived by his wife of 59 years, Ann (Warnick) Steimel.
