**D**aniel L. Thompson, 67, of Fort Myers, passed away Thursday, July 14, 2016. He was born September 8, 1948 in Indianapolis, IN and moved to Fort Myers in 1998. He retired from the Indianapolis Fire Department in 1993 following 26 years of service.
