**D**oris E. Potts, 91, of Fort Myers, passed away peacefully Tuesday, March 29, 2016. She was born March 7, 1925 in Hellertown, PA, the daughter of Walter and Mildred (Weaver) Geyer. Mrs. Potts is survived by her children: Deborah L. Williams (husband, John) of Fort Myers, Gregory D. Potts (wife, Mary Sue) of Cedar Park, TX and Dennis A. Potts (wife, Shelia) of Greenville, SC; her siblings: Charles Geyer (wife, Shirley) of Fort Myers, Richard Geyer of Hellertown, PA, Susan Worthington of Hendersonville, NC and David Worthington (wife, Sandy) of Fort Myers; 12 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.
