Shirley Ann (Cornelius) Campbell, age 83, of North Fort Myers, Florida and formerly of Erie, Pennsylvania, passed away peacefully on Wednesday March 2, 2016 at Hope Hospice, Cape Coral, Florida. Shirley was born on April 28, 1932 in Erie, Pennsylvania to the late Leon and Dorothy Cornelius. She was the beloved wife of Thomas Campbell who died in March, 2011. She was also preceded in death by a son, David Daniels in 2006, a step-son Mark Campbell 1990 and her sister Audrey Mason in 2015.
