We played in the band "Frenzy" together prior to his move to Marcellus, and I saw his new band "Ian" play the last time under that name prior to changing to "White Onyx." He first played a red Hagstrom guitar (later a Fender Mustang) that he bought from Dick Kahl at the Music Mart and played the first Jordan amplifier I ever saw. We tried to hold the band together after his move to his new town, and played a dance at Marcellus High so Scott could impress his new friends. That night we got snowed in after the dance and all curled together in empty refrigerator boxes behind the school freezing to death until Scott's family was able to get us so all the band, roadies and girlfriends could crash for the evening on their floor.
