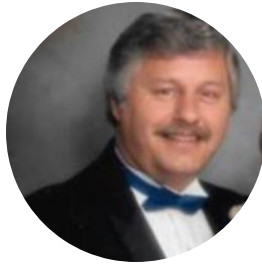

Phillip Ernest Felice, 77, of Fort Myers, passed away Sunday, November 8, 2015. He was born February 8, 1938, in Pontiac, MI and moved to Fort Myers from Knoxville, TN in 1990. He proudly served the United States Marines and attended Cypress Lake Presbyterian Church. He retired from Sea Ray Boats following 26 years of service.
