**R**ichard Lee Taylor passed away with his loving family by his side on Wednesday, July 22, 2015 following some recent health challenges. He was 83 years old. Richard was born on January 15, 1932 in Royalton Village, Illinois, the proud son of Ella Mae (Williams) and Daniel R. Taylor. He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Cora L. Taylor; four daughters, eleven grandchildren and sixteen great grandchildren.
