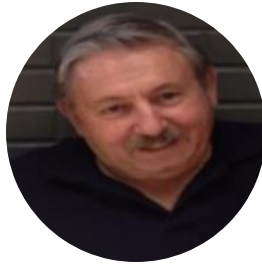

Salvatore Chiarelli, 76, of Cape Coral, passed away Friday, May 8, 2015. He was born September 24, 1938 in Brooklyn, NY. For over 30 years, Sal owned and operated Silver Shears Barber Shop in Lehigh Acres. He also worked as a carpenter and owned Sal's Custom Cabinets and prior to this, owned S & J Meat Provisions in NY. He was passionate about the Lion's Club and was a member for over 30 years of the Fort Myers Club where he held the Sight Chairman position raising money for people in need to receive eye services.
