James Earl Mackey, 73, of Cape Coral, passed away Saturday, December 13, 2014. He was born September 7, 1941 in Newark, NJ and moved to Cape Coral from Bricktown, NJ in 1988. He was a United States Navy Veteran aboard the U.S.S. Wasp during the Cuban Missile Crisis where he served as an Electrician's mate. Following his time in the Navy, he became a glazier and joined the Iron Workers Union in New York City. His work included the Statue of Liberty and the World Trade Center. He also attended St. Katharine Drexel Catholic Church. Mr. Mackey leaves to cherish his memory, his wife of 29 years, Lynne; his children: William J.
