Raymond E. Lutzen, 92 of Fort Myers, FLA and formerly of Niantic, CT, died on July 26, 2014, surrounded by his loving family. Raymond was born on September 8, 1921, to John and Martha Smith Lutzen. He was predeceased by his wife of 67 years, Margaret Davis Lutzen and four siblings. He leaves 4 children Susanne Jullarine, Gregory Lutzen and wife Frances, Beth Orth and husband Gregory, and Mary Lutzen, 9 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, and 2 great, great grandchildren.
