Steve served in the US Army as a young man. Steve retired as the owner of Steven Barri Salons located in central and northern New Hampshire and Vermont. He was an avid outdoorsman and motorcyclist. He was happiest when with his family, afield chasing ruffed grouse or astride a motorcycle, especially Harley-Davidsons in his later years. He was a proud man who walked his own path and left a trail for others to follow.
