Dorothy Woolard Lambing, 96, of Fort Myers, FL, passed away, Monday, February 24, 2014 in Cape Coral. She was a homemaker and long-time member of Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church, Ft. Myers. Dorothy was born April 15, 1917 in Beloit, WI to the late Clyde and Mabel Markley Woolard. After her mother's death in 1918, she moved with her father to Fort Pierce, FL in 1919.
