Errol Neil Weisberg, 55, passed away November 28, 2013. He was born on November 22, 1958 in Hartford, CT to Howard and the late Madeline (Zingesser) Weisberg. Errol attended schools in Hartford and Windsor, Conn. Errol earned a Bachelor's Degree from the American International College in Springfield, MA. Upon graduation, he became Manager of Fromex Colorlab and Camera in Fort Myers. Eventually, he followed his love of food and service in becoming the manager of the Lighthouse Restaurant and for the last two years he was employed by Ruby Tuesdays.
