Rudolph (Rudy) Francis Turk, 86, of North Fort Myers, Florida, departed this life on October 24, 2013. A Memorial Mass will be Celebrated for Rudolph at 12:00 PM Thursday, October 31, 2013 at St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church, 2157 Cleveland Ave., Fort Myers. Military honors will follow at 1:30 PM at Fort Myers Memorial Gardens Cemetery in the Field of Honor. Rudy was born in Willoughby, OH. He was a U. S. Navy Veteran, serving during World War II. Mr. Turk was a carpenter and general contractor. He and his family moved to Sarasota, Florida and later moved to North Fort Myers and resided with his daughter and son-in-law.
