Frank Paschall Odle, 92, passed away August 11, 2013 at his home in Cape Coral, Florida. He was born July 10, 1921 in Camden, Tennessee to the late Joseph and R.E. (Paschall) Odle. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his sisters, Mildred C. Odle and Virginia M. Edelson; brother, Joseph F. Odle Jr. and a great granddaughter, Madison Elise Wagner. He served our country as a 1st Sgt. in the US Army in Europe during WWII and received 5 battle stars. Frank graduated from the University of Tennessee with a BS in agriculture.
