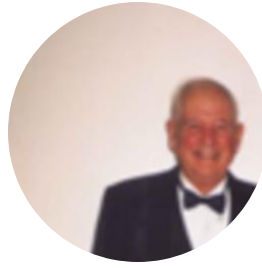

Roy C. Conrad, 85, years of age, of Estero, Florida passed away on July 28, 2013 in Port Charlotte, Florida. Roy was born in Jersey City, NJ on November 5, 1927.
