Russell G. Haigis, 64, of Lehigh Acres, FL, passed away Tuesday, October 4, 2011 following an extended illness. He was born November 18, 1946 in Saco, ME and moved to Lehigh Acres in 1998. He served the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War and retired from the Town of Scarborough Maine as Communications Director of Police and Fire Rescue. Mr. Haigis is survived by his wife of 10 years, Monique A.
