Clint R Kelly, 95, of Cape Coral, FL, passed away Thursday, March 31, 2011. He was born in Shobonier, Illinois, to Ira Kelly and Alpha Alta Andrews in 1915. Clint is predeceased by his loving wife, Evelyn (Susie); his two brothers, Ira and George; and two sisters Edna and Eva, and both parents. Clint was a graduate of Illinois Teachers College. He was a life long member Of NEA and other organizations. Mr. Kelly lived a very full life. He had many interests and things he loved about life, the greatest being his wife, Sue.
