## Paul E. Davidson

OCT 17, 1922 - MAR 7, 2011

**P**aul E. Davidson, 88, of Fort Myers, Florida passed away on Monday, March 7, 2011 at Gulf Coast Medical Center in Fort Myers, FL. Mr. Davidson was born October 17, 1922 in Marion, IN, a son of the late Sebborn G. Davidson and Mary B. Hodson. Paul was the first Postmaster of Cape Coral, FL and retired from the U.S. Postal Service as a Supervisor. He served his country proudly in the U.S. Air Force from October 1942 until November 1945. He had resided here since 1947 coming from Marion, IN. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Sylvia; his sons, Mike (Pam) Davidson, Mitch (Sharon) Davidson and Marshall Davidson; 7 grandchildren and several great grandchildren. Private funeral services will be held at Fort Myers Memorial Gardens Funeral Home on Saturday, March 12, 2011 at 2:30 PM. Interment will be in Fort Myers Memorial Gardens Cemetery.
