Margaret Devic, wife of retired FBI Agent Charles Devic died on January 7, 2010, in Fort Myers, FL. She was born March 27, 1930, in Shamokin, Pennsylvania. Peggy attended high school in Shamokin and later graduated from St. Joseph's College, Emmitsburg, Maryland. She was employed by the FBI in 1951 and was assigned to the Document Section of the Laboratory at FBI Headquarters, Washington, D.C., where she met and subsequently married Charles, a supervisor in Headquarters. Peggy resigned from the FBI in 1971, after 20 years, to be with her husband who was assigned to various offices throughout the country as Assistant Special Agent in Charge and Special Agent in Charge. Peggy was a member of the Roman Catholic Church of the Resurrection of Our Lord, Fort Myers. She is survived by her husband, Charles, a sister Roberta (William) Coleman, of Hilton Head, South Carolina, and a brother Lawrence (Ann) Bartol, of Shamokin, Pennsylvania. She has five nephews; Peter, John, James, and Mark Coleman and James Bartol and four nieces; Valerie, Michelle, Renee, and Simone.
