Neal J. Fitzgerald III Passed away on September 29th 2009 at his home after a brief illness. Born April 14th, 1967 in Natrona Heights, he was 42, and the son of Neal and Estelle (Stasia) Fitzgerald of Natrona Heights. Neal was an 1985 graduate of Highlands High School and 1988 graduate of Penn Technical Institute in Pittsburgh. He had resided in the Florida area for the past 11 years and was employed by Norton and Florida construction as a heavy equipment operator. He previously worked for Allegheny Ludlum in Brackenridge, PA, as a crane operator. Neal was of the catholic faith.
