**D**avid N. McKelvey, 90, of Ft. Myers, FL, passed away November 8, 2019. He served as an officer in the Navy on USS Stembel, DD-644, during the Korean Conflict. David was a graduate of Muskingum College in New Concord, Ohio, and Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. He was a high school business education teacher, department head, and Vocational Coordinator in Euclid, Ohio and then became the founding Director of the Business Division (now “Dean”) as Lakeland Community College in Kirtland, Ohio.
