Lyle R. Danielson of Fort Myers, Florida passed away peacefully on Monday, October 28, 2019 at the HealthPark Care and Rehabilitation Center following some recent health challenges. He was 92 years old. Mr. Danielson was a long-time teacher in the Lee County School District and was a strong supporter of environmental conservation efforts, including the Conservation 20/20 Program and the Calusa Nature Center. His advocacy both as a teacher and naturalist was greatly appreciated and will be fondly remembered and missed. Immediate funeral ceremonies are private. Arrangements for Lyle's final care have been entrusted to Fort Myers Memorial Gardens Funeral Home. Cremation rites will be accorded. Lyle's remains will be laid to rest during an upcoming private service at the La Pieta Memorial located inside the Hall of Crucifixion at Memorial Gardens Cemetery, 1589 Colonial Boulevard, Fort Myers, Florida 33907, (239) 936-0555. I have a fond memory of traveling with Lyle to Tallahassee to comment before the governor and cabinet on critical issues of the day. Lyle, and the late Roger Clark, joined me to bring the concept of a conservation land acquisition program in Lee County to the Board of County Commissioners in 1995. The concept, with the support of many Lee County residents, went on to become the Lee County Conservation 2020 program in 1996. More than 30,000 acres in Lee County are now part of the 2020 program.
