**R**obert William Trabucco Sr., 74, a USMC Veteran and longtime resident of Cape Coral, Florida passed away on February 7, 2020 with his family at his bedside.

Robert a.k.a “Bob” was born in Newark, New Jersey to Nicholas Arthur Trabucco and Rose DeRose Trabucco on November 30, 1945. He enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1963 where he was a photographer during the Vietnam War. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Rosanne Ricca Trabucco.

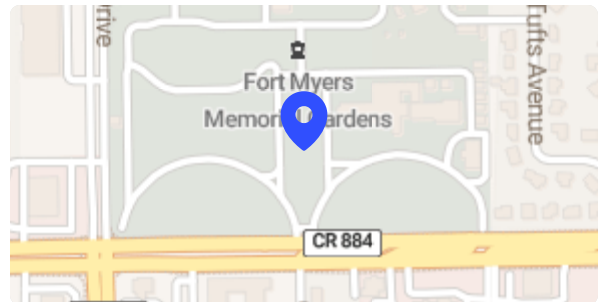

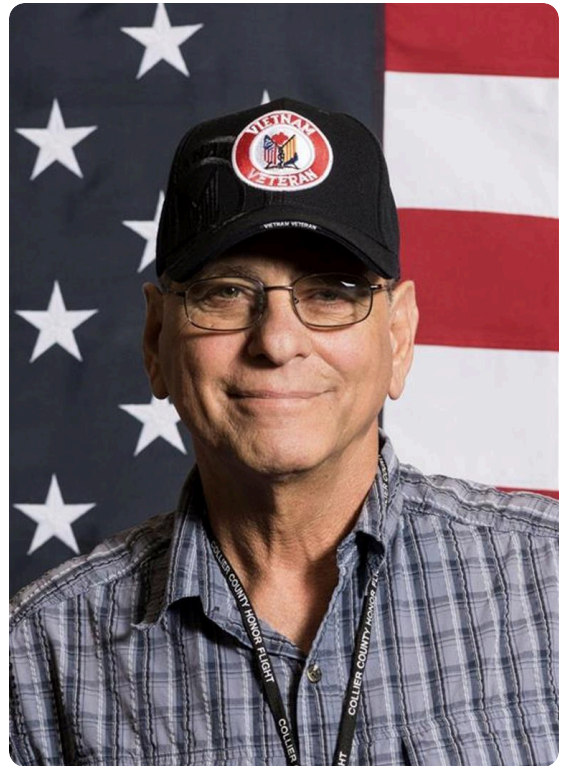
