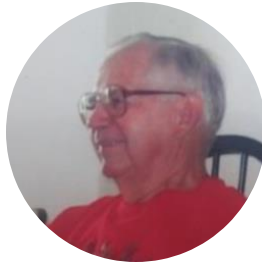

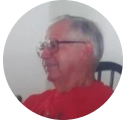

**R**obert Emerson Munro, better known as Bob, of La Belle and formerly of Cape Coral, Florida passed away peacefully at home with his loved ones by his side on Tuesday, February 25, 2020. He was 88 years old.
