Virginia Catherine Kloiber, 87, a Matlacha, FL resident since 1992, formerly of Milwaukee, WI passed away Friday, February 21, 2020 in Mountain Home, AR. She was born March 25, 1932 in Kewaskum, WI to Sylvester and Frances Thull, now deceased.

Virginia was a long time parishioner of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Church in Bokeelia, FL. Virginia graduated from St. Mary's Nursing School with a degree in Registered Nursing. 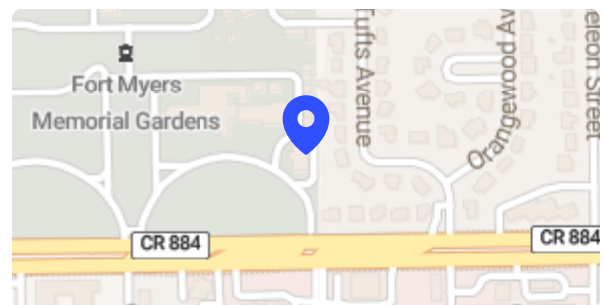
