Jerry was a remarkable salesman with a warm Southern charm. He began a career with White Motor Company and became their National Distribution Manager traveling all over the US and Puerto Rico. Jerry eventually began a career selling construction equipment and worked with several large corporations. During that time he lived in Canton, OH, Atlanta, GA, New Orleans, LA and Jacksonville, FL. Jerry eventually started his own business, in Jacksonville, buying, fixing up and selling construction equipment (mostly cranes). It was a popular bar and grill type place with live local musicians, games and pool tables.

They moved to Fort Myers after Jerry retired in 1999. Jerry was a devoted, selfless and honorable man. He was a loving and protective Dad to their two daughters, Josette and Amanda. His family's happiness and well being was so important to him. He felt his life was blessed with his Daughters and even more blessed with each of his 4 Grandchildren. He was so proud of them all and had a special relationship with each of them. 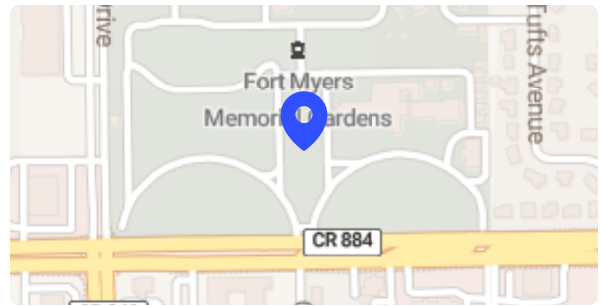

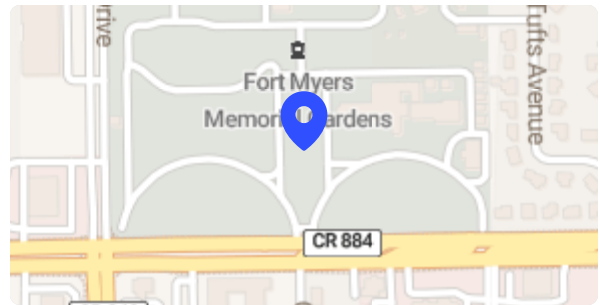
