A Funeral Service will be held privately. Interment will be in Memorial Gardens Cemetery in the Eternal Light section of the cemetery.



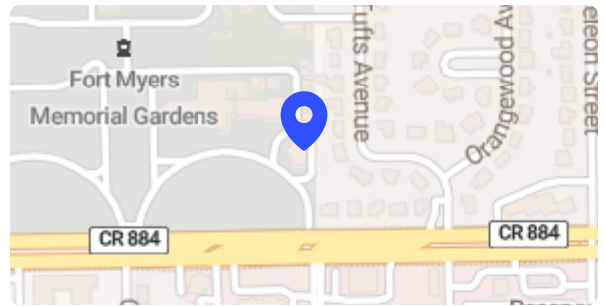
