A Catholic funeral service will be held at the graveside on Saturday, September 4, 2021 at 10 AM at Fort Myers Memorial Gardens funeral home.

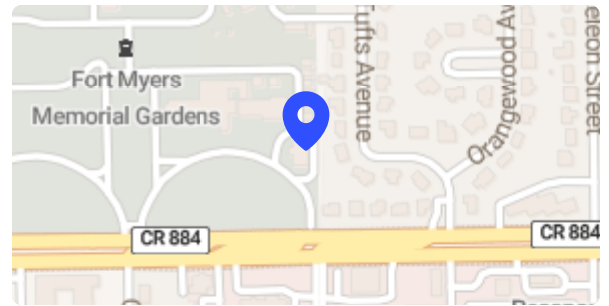
