**I**t is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Joan Nocerino, our loving and devoted wife, mother, and grandmother.

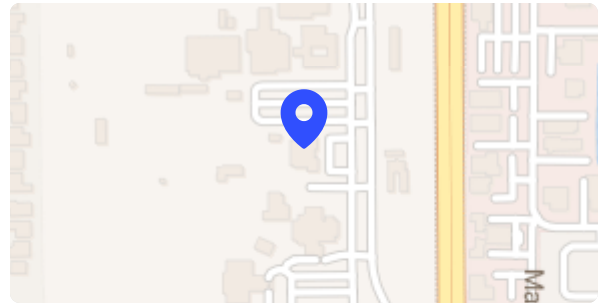
