Carol Anne Sinopoli, 68, died November 19, 2021, with her loving children and goddaughter by her side in Fort Myers, FL.

Carol graduated with high honors from the Academy of Mount Saint Vincent in Tuxedo Park, NY. 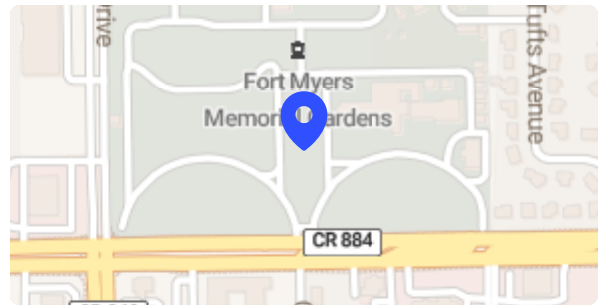

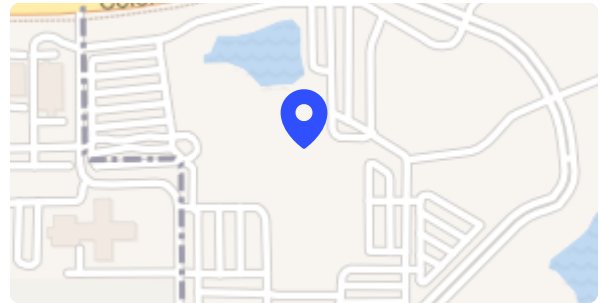
