Leslie James Harvey of Naples, Florida passed away peacefully with his loving family by his side on Saturday, December 25, 2021 following some recent health setbacks. He was 82 years old.

Les was born in Brooklyn, New York on September 30, 1939, the proud son to Antoinette (Piro) and Leslie Edward Harvey. He was a Veteran of the United States Army and for many years was a Police Officer serving with the 1st Unit of the Anti-Crime Division in the Midtown South Precinct of the Police Department for the City of New York. 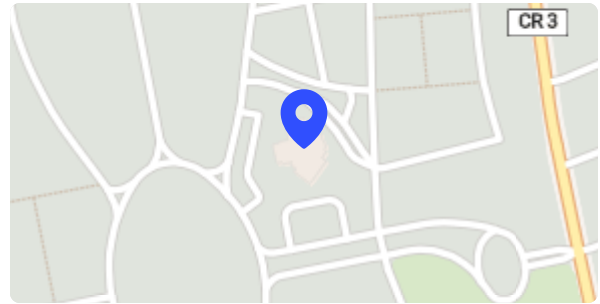

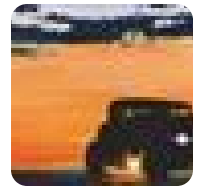

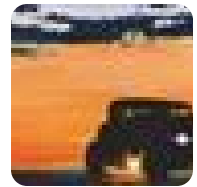
