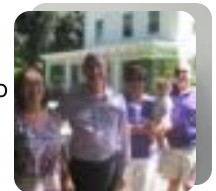

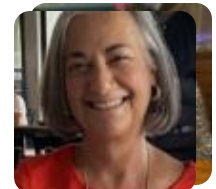

One of my favorite memories is going to Cypress Lake high school track to complete one of our running workouts. The track was locked up so we put our bikes up against the fence climbed using our bikes as a stepstool and jumped over the fence to work out or run intervals. We joked that the next days newspapers might read "to Lee County teachers arrested for breaking into Cypress Lake high school track". Also we hadn't really thought about how we were going to get back over the fence to get on our bikes and ride home. Cindi was in her mid-50s and I was close to 60. Somehow with the help of a friend we got out of there. We would often times arrange to meet up for a run work out around the neighborhood in the villas. Invariably I would see her walking toward me and we would have on the same exact workout clothes. 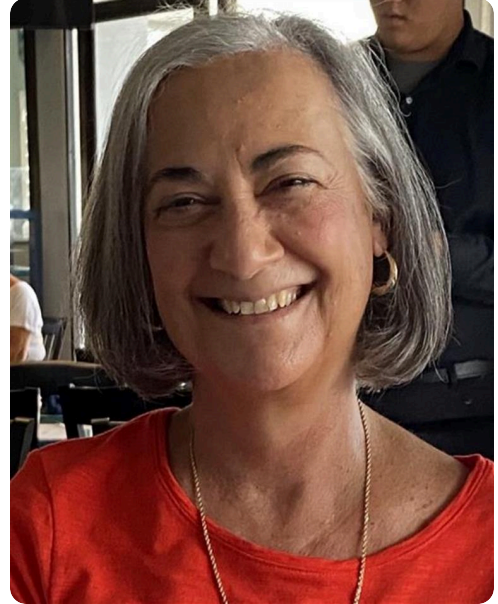
