On Monday June 20, 2022 Richard James Haberle Jr, loving husband and extraordinary father, passed away at the age of 75. His last breath was taken surrounded by love in Tallahassee, Fl.

Richard aka as Habe was born in Philadelphia, PA September 27, 1946 to Richard James Sr and Verna Haberle. Habe was the second oldest of 4 children. Shortly after graduating high school, Habe joined the United States Air Force and honorably served in the Vietnam War. Following the war Habe went on to work in the air freight business and worked for companies such as PanAm with pride. 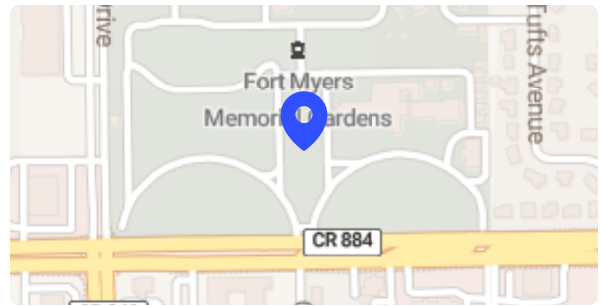
