Judith (Judy) Barnes Brock, 84, of Fort Myers, FL and Woburn, MA, went to be with her Lord and Savior on March 8th due to a heart incident following a stent procedure.

Judy loved well and was well loved. The devoted and loving wife to Larry for 63 years, Judy was a caring and selfless mother, sister, and grand and great grandmother. She was also the sponsor mother of Ry Bin, whom she enveloped into the family. She joins her parents, Beulah and Russell Barnes, and daughter Karen who preceded her to heaven.

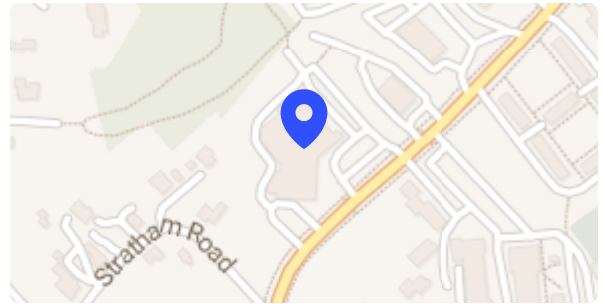

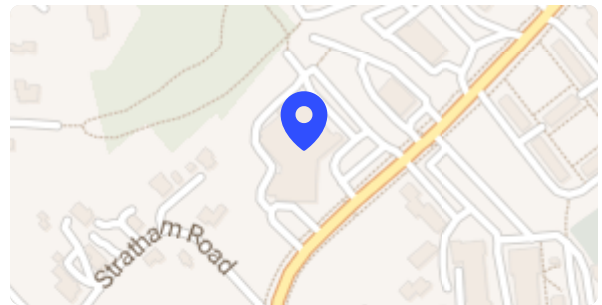
