D Bernie Downes, 90, passed away March 23, 2023 at his home in Cape Coral, FL. Bernie was married to Janet Downes for 69 years before her passing in March 2022. Bernie was born on June 4, 1932 to Frank and Evelyn (Weed) Downes in West Penobscot, Maine. He graduated from Clark High School in 1950. Bernie married Janet on August 16, 1952 and started a family. Bernie served in the Army during the Korean Conflict. He was stationed at Fort Bliss, El Paso, TX as a radar technician.
