There will be a reception following Bobby's service at Gulf Coast Church of Christ.

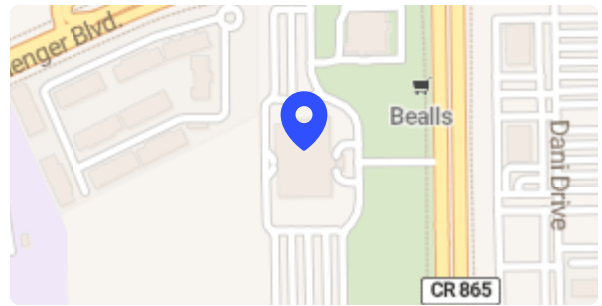
