Henry Earl Webber, III, 83, born in Nashville, TN on Sept. 11th, 1939, passed away June 20th, 2023, in Deerfield Beach, FL. He was a devoted son, brother, husband, and father.

As a young man he was a graduate of Sewanee Military Academy and attended the University of Tennessee. He would go on to be co-owner of the Gallatin Block Company with his brother in Gallatin, TN. He was married in 1962 to Loerita Perry Webber, to whom he was married for almost 60 years. Later he moved his family to Fort Myers, Florida where he became the Regional Manager for Florida Mining and Materials until his retirement. 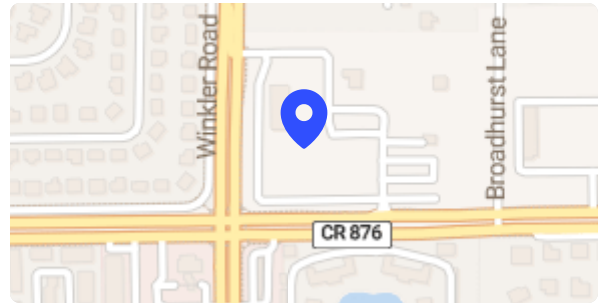

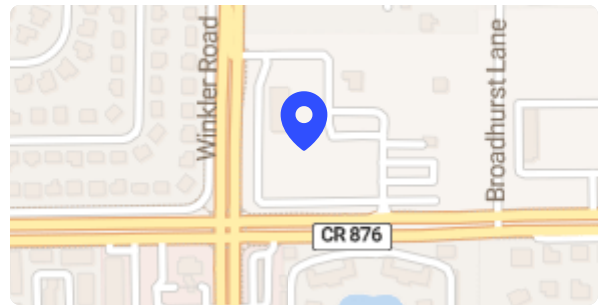
