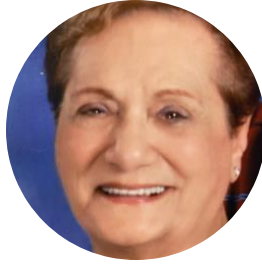

Memorial donations may be made to St. John XXIII Catholic Church in memory of Lillian Gill.

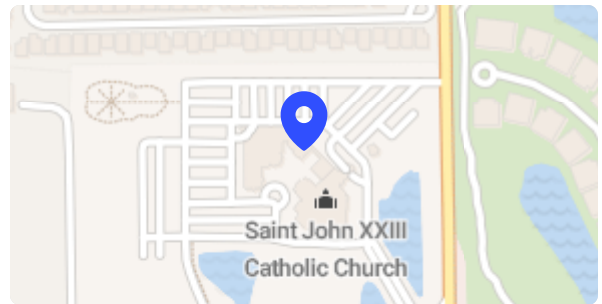
