**C**arolyn Malone Sherman, 86, passed away on February 18th, 2024 at Barrington Terrace in Fort Myers, Florida. Born March 20th, 1937 in Canton Ohio, she was the only child of the late Charles Franklin Malone and Vera Crim Malone. She married the love of her life, M Dean Sherman, on June 18th, 1955 in Galion Ohio and they moved to Fort Myers, Florida in 1973 with their daughters. Dean preceded her in death in September, 1991.

Carolyn was a 1955 graduate of Galion High School. She worked for the School District of Lee County Florida as a kindergarten assistant at Villas Elementary School.
