# Wolfgang Rudolf Reisinger

NOV 20, 1948 - MAR 18, 2024

**W**olfgang Rudolf Reisinger of Lehigh Acres, Florida passed away unexpectedly and peacefully on Monday, March 18, 2024 following some recent health challenges. He was 75 years old.

Wolfgang was born in Vienna, Austria on November 20, 1948. He grew up in a small family setting with his Mom and Dad, Erna & Otto Reisinger in the 12th District of the Austrian capital Vienna. After attending elementary school and high school, he attended the Vienna University of Technology, eventually earning his bachelor's degree in engineering. While living in Vienna, Wolfgang met Monika, his current wife. After earning his degree, he was offered a position in the research and development unit with Porsche in Stuttgart, Germany. He accepted the position and both Wolfgang and Monika moved together to Germany. On October 1, 1970, Wolfgang and Monika got married, and gave birth to their son Andreas on June 14, 1973.

Wolfgang switched from Porsche to SIHI-Halberg, an engineering company, and while moving into leadership positions within the organization, Wolfgang and his family settled in Munich. Through work Wolfgang and his family were introduced to Florida in 1993. Ultimately, in 1996, Wolfgang and his family permanently moved from Germany to the United States.

Starting a new career as property manager, Wolfgang eventually acquired his real estate license, starting yet another career in real estate and was still an active REALTOR when he passed away.

Throughout his life, Wolfgang touched a lot of people, and was loved by so many. He leaves behind his wife Monika, his son Andreas, his daughter-in-law DiAnna, and his grandkids, Morgan and Madison.

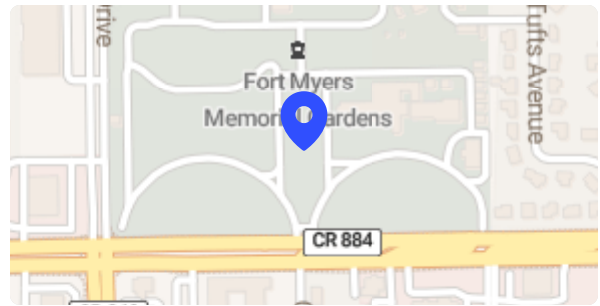
