# Lewis Elmer Sharp

**L**ewis Elmer Sharp, 94 of Marlinton WV passed away on Friday, March 15, 2024 at the home of his daughter in Cape Coral, FL after an extended illness.

He was born in Marlinton, WV on November 1, 1929 to the late Dolpha Yeager Sharp and Regina Sue (nee Underwood) Sharp.

Lewis was a proud United States Air Force Veteran serving from 1949-1953 as a member of the crash & rescue team at Andrews Air Force Base. After his time in the Air Force he eventually returned to Marlinton and began his own auto body business "Sharp's Body Shop". He enjoyed hunting and fishing his entire life, and after retiring from his business, he lived his dream during the summer & fall season for several years, as a big game hunting guide in Wyoming.
